Resolution 15-11 Upon a motion by Director McMillan, second by Director Rickards, and vote (Ek, Kiel, McMillan, and Rickards in favor; McKenna abstain; Johnston and Vacio absent), Resolution 15-11 A Resolution of the Board of Directors of the San Miguel Consolidated Fire Protection District Relating to the Industrial Disability Retirement of Engineer Paul Vircsik, was approved.
- 8. Pepper Drive Bid Award Battalion Chief Hunt addressed the Board and provided handouts on the cost breakdown regarding the construction of the Station 19/69 Apparatus Building, one with Hunter Steel Construction items covered in the bid and the other handout with additional costs not included in the Hunter Steel Construction bid. Director McMillan asked that the minutes reflect his statement that the Board of Directors had been told the purchase of the Pepper Drive property was to better serve the constituents in Bostonia and the Board had been assured by Staff that it was independent of any funding. Upon a motion by Director McMillan, second by Director Rickards, and vote (Ek, Kiel, McKenna, McMillan, and Rickards in favor; Johnston and Vacio absent), to award the construction contract to Hunter Steel Construction, was approved.

Vehicle Purchase Upon a motion by Director Kiel, second by Director McMillan, and vote (Ek, Kiel, McMillan, and Rickards in favor; McKenna opposed; Johnston and Vacio absent), to place \$40,000 into the Vehicle Replacement Budget and authorize the purchase of a new chief officer vehicle from the State of California, Department of General Services, Fleet Vehicles Trucks contract, for approximately \$32,595, was approved.

INFORMATIONAL AGENDA ITEMS:

- 11. CSA 115 Fire Chief Chaney provided a brief update on CSA 115.
- 12. Reports:
 - a. Committee Reports: Director Rickards reported CSA 69 is considering the purchase of vests for Tactical Medics, and will be placing that on their next meeting agenda.
 - Director McMillan reported the next Finance Committee meeting will be moved from the Regular Meeting of August 18 at 9:30am to a Special Meeting on August 25 at 10:00am. He also recapped items discussed by the Finance Committee.
 - b. Directors Reports: Director McKenna requested an update on evacuation routes for Millar Ranch Road and Fowler Canyon. Fire Chief Chaney reported that Deputy Fire Marshal Tony Morgan researched and has provided a link to reports assessing the evacuation routes. Director McKenna asked that Staff be assigned to inquire about using utility company roads as fire access and evacuation routes.
 - c. Monthly Activity Report: Fire Chief Chaney noted there was nothing additional to report. Director McKenna requested the total number of runs within the District and the total number of runs (in/out) by apparatus, be changed to a 13-month format.
 - d. Correspondence: Fire Chief Chaney noted several pieces of correspondence had been received by the District.
 - e. Action Plan Recap:
 - Agendize the request from the San Miguel Firefighters Foundation to continue to allow the storage of the Crown Fire Engine at Station 16/66.
 - Obtain appraisal for Station 19/69.
 - Deputy Fire Marshal Tony Morgan to contact utility companies regarding usage of utility roads as evacuation routes for Fowler Canyon and Millar Ranch Road.
 - Look into Zone 2 Contract cost differential.
